WHAT IS THE SHOEBOX APPEAL?

The Shoebox Appeal is a campaign run by a charity called "The Samaritans." It gives shoeboxes filled with food and other donations to homeless people who are a lot less lucky than we are.

HOW CAN I TAKE PART?

HOW DO I MAKE ONE?

1. Find a shoebox
2. Fill it with 10 items of food or drinks.

These can to be:

- canned foods that don't go off
easily
-chips or salty snacks (e.g salami,
crackers)

-sweets, chocolate and cookies -drinks that don't contain alcohol

You can also add some plastic or wooden utensils if you want. You could also add some items of clothing (gloves, hat, scarf...ect.)

Make sure that the food is non-perishable.

4. Wrap it in wrapping paper
5. Bring it to a collection
